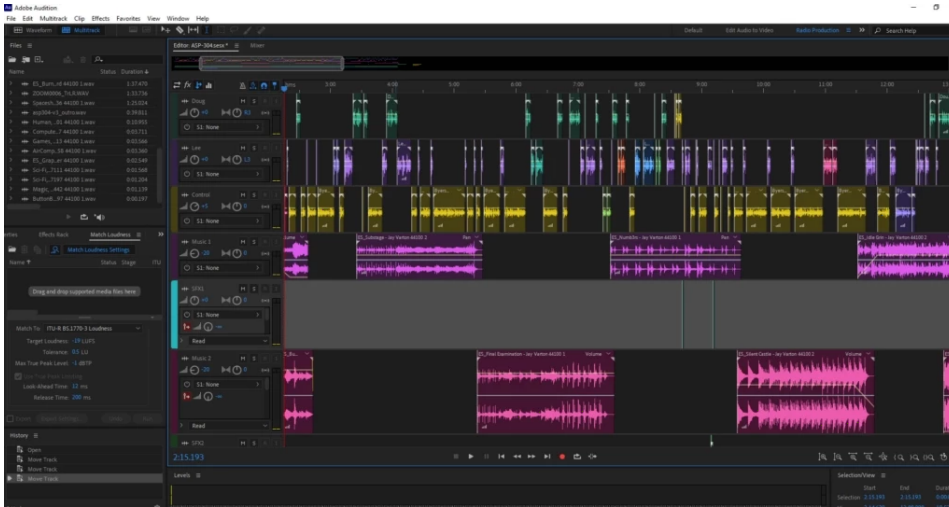


Adobe Audition
